When to urgently refer directly to our Neck Lump Clincs?1

- · Neck Lump increasing in size; or
- Neck Lump greater than 2 cm in size; or
- Neck Lump present for more than 3 weeks that has changed; or
- Neck Lump present for 6 weeks or more; or
- · Widespread lymphadenopathy > 2cm; or
- B symptoms: night sweats, generalised itch, weight loss, fever

The neck lump clinic team is proud of the levels of service they are able to offer. This service provides an excellent standard of care meeting international best practice.2,3

The benefits to your patients are:







- Ultrasound assessment (neck and thyroid)
- Immediate ultrasound-quided Fine Needle Aspirate biopsy performed if indicated
- Immediate biopsy assessment where required
- · Clinical assessment, explanation of test results and treatment planning

Our results so far4

- 1238 neck lump patients assessed
- → 99% of patients given diagnosis following assessment
- + 49% discharged with reassurance after a single appointment
- → 10% cancer diagnosis

Our multi-disciplinary team has expertise in the assessment, diagnosis and management of neck lumps and forms part of the MercyAscot Head and Neck Service. The team works together to deliver the best possible care for your patients.
